

IMPORTANT TIPS:


- Ensure that item's adapter is plugged in with the screw cap tightened at the Function Control Box and plugged in the wall.
- Ensure that the switch on the function control box is on the desired setting.
- If not functioning properly (ex: head and hands don't light up, head doesn't move), ensure that cables are connected to their corresponding cable as shown in the instruction sheet.
- Be sure nothing is blocking movement or caught in moving parts.
- Ensure that the floor or surface that the item sits on is flat and level.
- Ensure that the volume is not all the way down.
- Be sure nothing is blocking the sensor. Prop only speaks on Sensor Timer Mode or when activated with a Step Pad. See Operations Instructions page 5 for complete details.







































OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

The 12 ft. Levitating Reaper is powered by an adapter. Plug in the power adapter into a standard power outlet. To turn on the 12 ft. Levitating Reaper, press the button on the Function Control Box. Press the button again to switch to the Timer setting. Press the button a third time time to switch to the Sensor Setting. Press the button a fourth time to turn the item Off.

NOTE: Set to TIMER and SENSOR mode to see the 12 ft. Levitating Reaper speak and move. Between sensor activa-tions, the 12 ft. Levitating Reaper LEDs will remain ON.

LIGHTS ONLY / ÉCLAIRAGE UNIQUEMENT / SÓLO LUCES

In this setting, the lights of the item will activate indefinitely until the setting is changed. This setting mode does not have any animation or sound.

SENSOR / DÉTECTEUR / SENSOR In this setting, the lights will always stay on, but the sound and animation of the item will activate for 1 activity cycle anytime the Infrared (IR) Sensor detects movement. The Infrared (IR) Sensor has a range of up to 4 m/13 ft. and will activate when someone comes within an 80 degree angle from left to right, as well as from above and below.

TIMER / MINUTEUR/ TEMPORIZADOR In this setting, there is an active period of 6 hours and an inactive period of 18 hours. During the 6 active hours, to function will behave like Sensor Mode. The Infrared (IR) Sensor cannot be triggered during the inactive 18 hour period.


